## CONDITIONS AND RULES

1. The Competition will be run to Pony Club Eventing Rules 2010.
2. Ruling date for ages is 1st January 2010. No rider under the age of 9 years or horse/pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
3. Competitors must wear correct riding clothes. A riding hat to the current BSEN 1384 minimum standard, must be worn and chinstraps fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must not have fixed peaks. Body Protectors & Medical Armbands are compulsory and must be worn when mounted.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to abandon any class or alter any prize.
6. Excessive use of the whip or bad language will not be tolerated and the Competitor will be asked to leave the course.
7. Children must be supervised and dogs must be on a lead at all times.
8. Outside assistance is forbidden in all classes.
9. All riders must give way to competitors travelling at a faster pace.
10. No horse/pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
11. In the event of cancellation by the ECC, £2 of each entry will be withheld for administration costs.
12. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate within 7 days of the event.
13. All droppings and rubbish must be removed from the horse box park.
14. Any objection must be lodged with the Secretary, within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10 which will not be refunded if the objection is overruled
15. The decision of the Judges is final in all respects
16. Photographer attending, if you do not wish to be photographed please notify the Secretary with your entry
17. Neither stopwatches nor mobile phones are permitted on the the course

## DIRECTIONS TO CARLTON CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

From the south and east follow A6 to Oakley, take signs for Pavenham & Carlton. From the North & West follow A428 to Lavendon, take signs to Harrold & Carlton. From either direction Carlton is situated on the top of Carlton hill, clearly signed.

Sat Nav users, please avoid Stevington as access is severely restricted for large vehicles.

The bypass around the south of Bedford linking the A428 Cambridge Northampton road is still incomplete. The associated road works can cause some confusion and delay. Grid Reference SP970552.
